

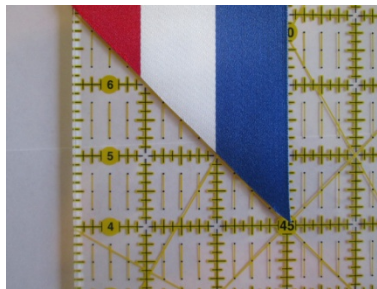
Sash Instructions for “1941 March” Payson, UT Temple Cultural Celebration

Materials:

3” wide ribbon (provided for you)
thread to match ribbon
clear fingernail polish or “Fray Check” to finish the ribbon edges
good fabric scissors
sewing machine or serger

Instructions:

1. Cut a 60” piece of ribbon (make about 4 dozen in each color 70” long for some of the tall youth)
2. Fold the ribbon in half. Using a good pair of fabric scissors, cut the ends at a 45 degree angle.



3. Apply clear fingernail polish or fray check to both ends of the ribbon so they won't fray.
4. With right sides together, use a ¼” seam to sew or serge the ends of the ribbon together. Be careful not to twist the ribbon. The sash will need to lie flat when worn. Be sure to “tie off” the thread at the beginning and end of the seam so the stitching won't come undone. If using a serger, you'll want to machine straight stitch or zig-zag over the seam so the ends are finished and won't come unsewn.
5. Store these in a safe place where they won't get wrinkled. Try looping several of them over a hanger (or something similar) until the dress rehearsals.
